This primarily is a multi-pitch ice climbing experience course however candidates will be trained and assessed for the Winter Climbing Foundation (WCF) qualification. It is an ideal course for developing climbing skills and a unique opportunity to gain invaluable logbook experience towards higher-level qualifications.

PRE-REQUISITES

Candidates must have successfully completed as a minimum BRC/RCP and have experience or working in the winter environment. Applications will be selected and must be supported by a current logbook. This is not a course for beginners!

COST

£450.00

This includes flights to and from Norway, in country transport, accommodation, catering, climbing equipment, instruction and insurance.

WHERE

Rjukan – Imagine a place with more than 150 frozen waterfalls, almost all of which have easy access and a stable climate that guarantees long periods of cold weather (-20 degrees). Add in a local community that welcomes visiting ice climbers, dramatic World War II history and you can only be in Rjukan, Norway.
